The "strength, self care and wellness" program truly reflected the department's vision of nurturing strength, mindfulness and wellness among the young generation.



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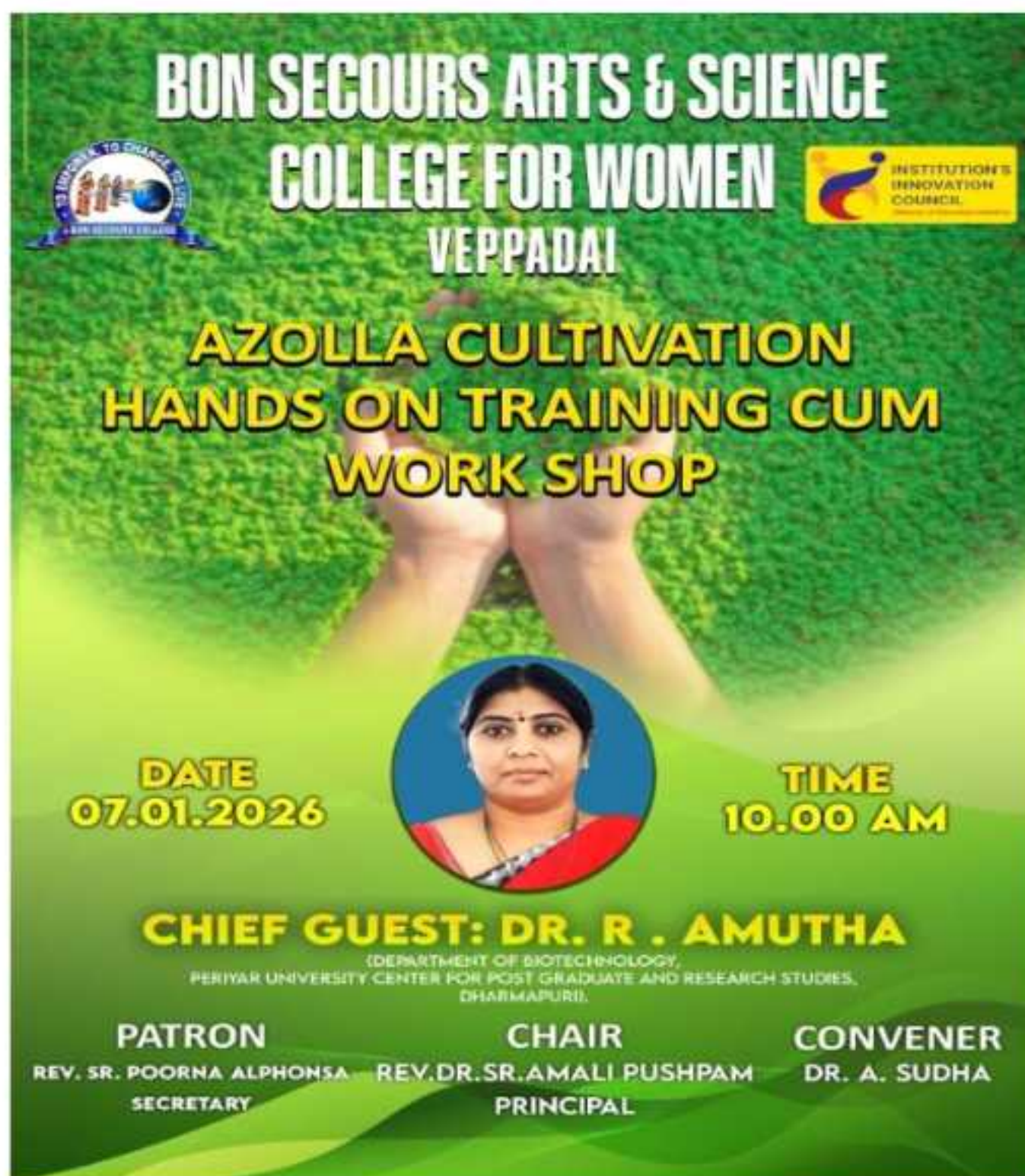

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AZOLLA CULTIVATION HANDS ON TRAINING CUM WORKSHOP

Azolla cultivation workshop was conducted at our college to promote awareness about sustainable agriculture and eco-friendly farming practices. Azolla is a fast-growing aquatic fern widely used as a bio-fertilizer and as a nutritious feed supplement for livestock and poultry.

Objective of the workshop

- To create awareness about the importance and benefits of Azolla cultivation.
- To provide hands on training on low-cost Azolla production techniques.
- To provide both theoretical knowledge and practical exposure to students.

Description of the workshop:

The workshop began with Tamizh thaai Vazhthu and a prayer song followed by the welcome speech by our professor. Mrs.K. Sangeetha. The inauguration session was successful with lighting of the lamp, welcome note by our respectable Head of the Department. Dr. A. Sudha. Then our chief guest Dr. R. Amutha gave the informative and valuable presentation about the Azolla cultivation.



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We arranged for the delicious lunch. Following the lecture session, a hands-on training was conducted. Students were trained in the practical aspects of Azolla cultivation, including pit preparation, water level maintenance, nutrient supplementation, inoculation and harvesting method. The interactive session allowed participants to clarify their doubts and actively engage in the cultivation process. Azolla grown in our pit will be used for further purposes, for sale and as inoculum for other pits.

Outcome of the workshop:

- Participants gained practical knowledge and skills in Azolla cultivation.
- Students gained the economic and environmental benefits of Azolla.
- Awareness about organic farming and sustainable agriculture was enhanced.
- The workshop motivated the students to implement Azolla cultivation techniques.
- The workshop provided the public with knowledge to start their own projects.

Conclusion:

The Azolla cultivation Hands -on Training cum workshop was successfully conducted and received positive feedback from participants. The workshop effectively met its objectives by combining theoretical knowledge with practical training. Such initiatives contribute significantly to skill development and environmental awareness among students. Finally, our immense program concluded with vote of thanks by our professor. 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Visit to Pasteur Institute of India, Coonoor

An Industrial Visit was organized by the Department of Science, Bon Secours Arts and Science College for Women on 25th February 2026, to the Pasteur Institute of India. The visit was arranged as a one-day educational trip with the objective of providing practical exposure to students in the field of microbiology, vaccine production, and fermentation technology.

A total of 77 students along with 5 faculty members participated in this industrial visit. The visit was both educational and informative, giving students real-time industrial knowledge beyond classroom learning.

About the Institute

The Pasteur Institute of India, located in Coonoor, Tamil Nadu, is a premier institute engaged in the production of vaccines and research in microbiology and immunology. The institute plays a vital role in public health by manufacturing life-saving vaccines and conducting scientific research.

Objectives of the Visit

The main objectives of the industrial visit were. To understand the process of vaccine production. To gain knowledge about fermentation techniques used in industries. To observe laboratory practices and biosafety measures. To learn about vaccine storage, handling, and injection preparation. To bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application.

Activities and Learning Experience

1. Vaccine Production Process:

The students were given a detailed explanation about the stages involved in vaccine manufacturing. The experts explained, Selection and preparation of microbial



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strains, Cultivation of microorganisms under controlled conditions, Inactivation or attenuation of pathogens, Purification and formulation of vaccines, Quality control and safety testing. Students understood how strict quality standards are maintained before vaccines are released for public use.

2. Fermentation Techniques:

The visit provided practical exposure to fermentation technology. Students learned about: Use of fermenters (bioreactors), Maintenance of sterile conditions, Monitoring parameters such as temperature, pH, and oxygen levels, Growth of microorganisms for vaccine production. The technical staff demonstrated how large-scale fermentation is carried out in industrial setups.

3. Vaccine Injection and Handling:

The students were also briefed on: Proper storage of vaccines (cold chain system), Safe handling procedures, Sterilization techniques, Preparation of vaccine doses for injection, Importance of maintaining hygiene during administration. This session helped students understand the importance of safety and precision in healthcare practices.

4. Laboratory Techniques and Safety Measures

The scientists explained various laboratory techniques, including: Aseptic techniques, Use of laminar airflow chambers, Sterilization using autoclaves, Waste management and disposal, Biosafety precautions. Students observed different laboratory instruments and gained knowledge about their functions.

Benefits of the Visit

Enhanced practical understanding of microbiology concepts. Exposure to real-time industrial processes. Improved awareness about vaccine production and public health. Motivation for higher studies and research careers. Strengthened teamwork and observation skills.



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Conclusion:

The industrial visit to the Pasteur Institute of India, Coonoor, was a highly successful and enriching experience for the students of the Department of Science. It provided valuable insights into vaccine production, fermentation technology, and laboratory safety practices. The visit successfully connected classroom theory with practical industrial applications. Overall, the trip was educational, informative, and beneficial for all participants.

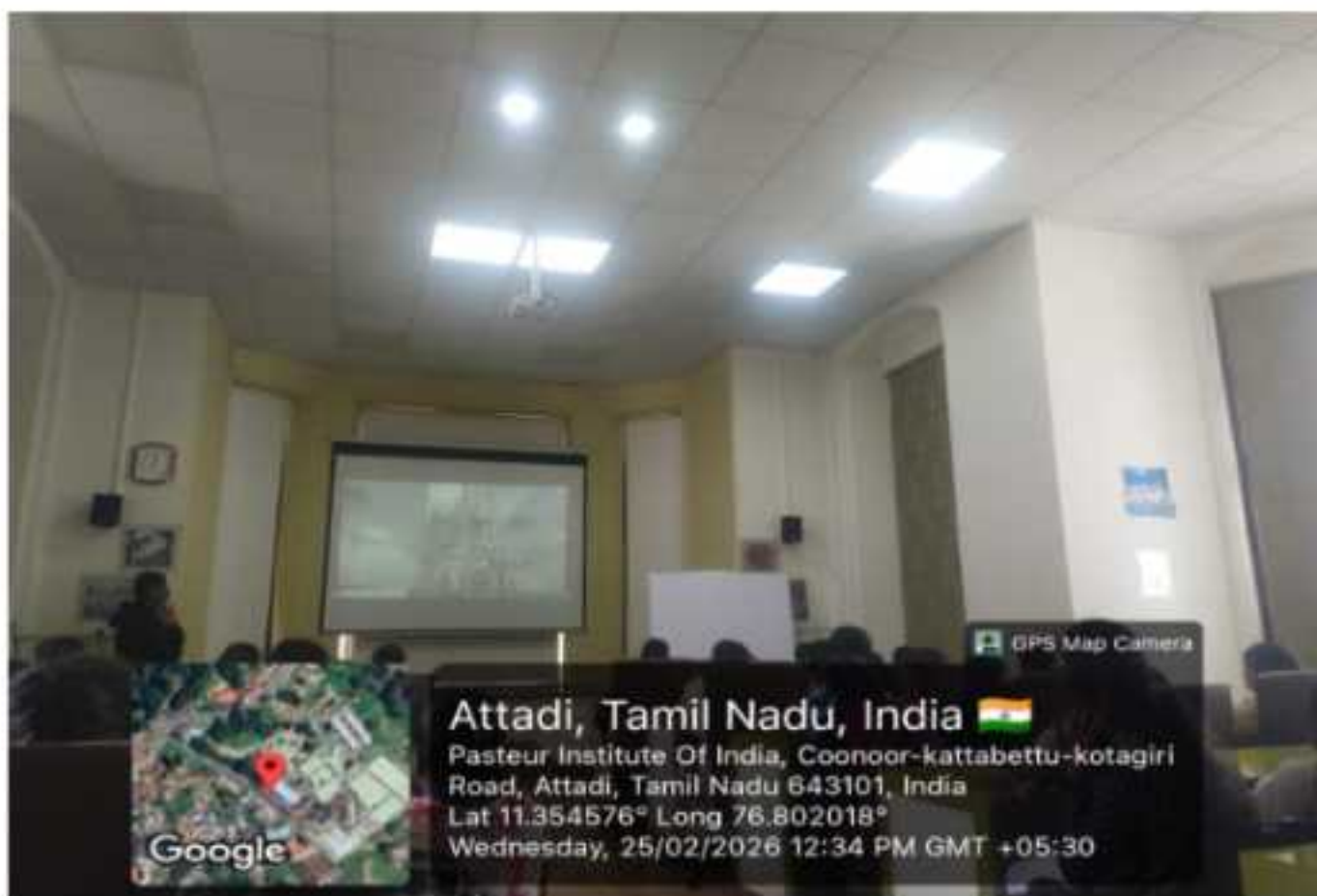

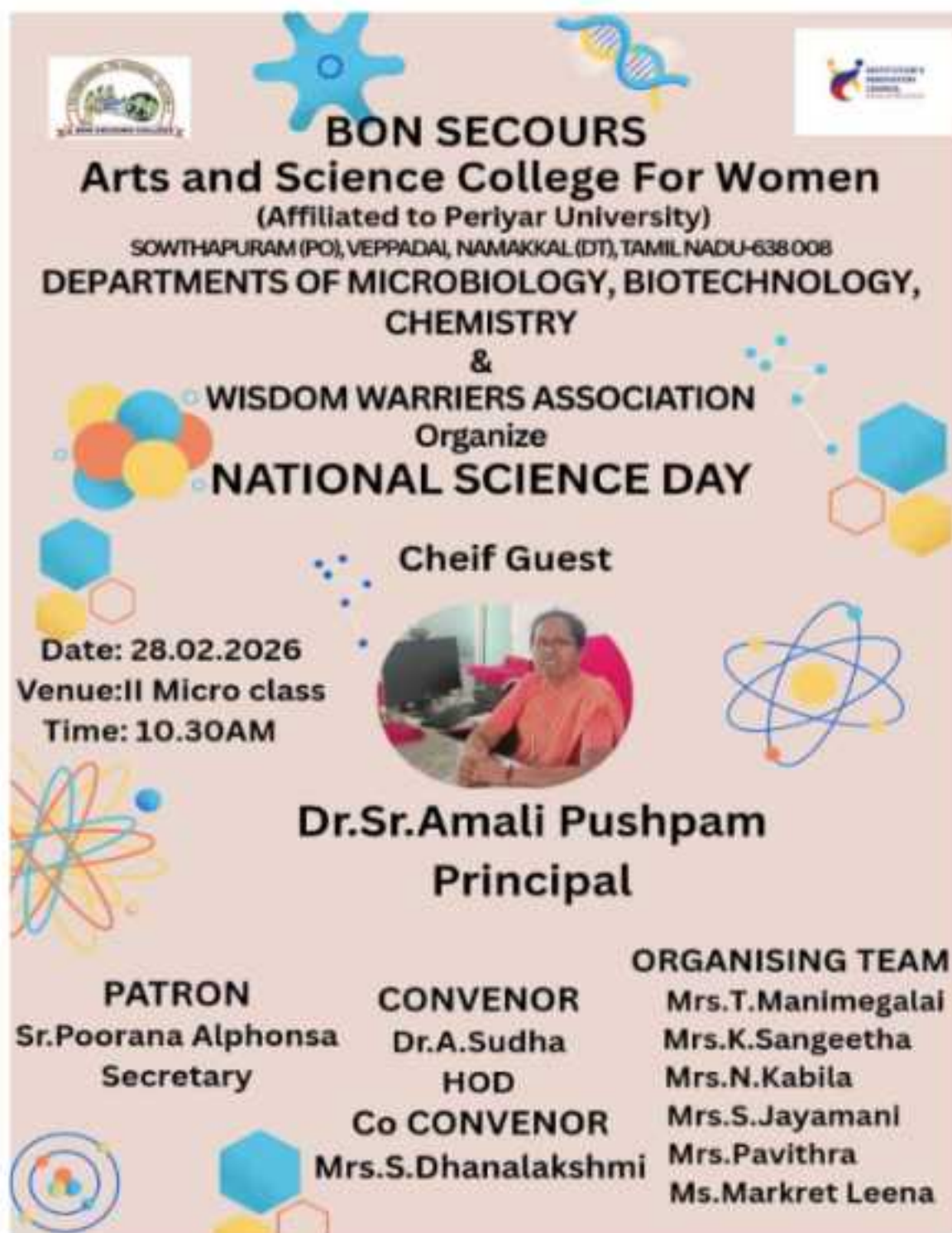
